

# 2022 Athlete Application Overview

Thank you for your interest in competing in STIHL TIMBERSPORTS®. This application packet provides all potential competitors a general overview of the 2022 season.

For 2022, we intend to conduct competitions as usual, and bring back live audiences to all events! This year we are planning four (4) regional qualifier competitions for men, women, and rookies, culminating in a national U.S. Championship. In addition, we are planning on hosting a men's U.S. Trophy competition.

With the evolving pandemic situation, we must remain flexible and implement alternative approaches if necessary. We may have to adjust or modify the competition schedule and format, and/or the athlete pool selection. Our goal for now is to establish a ranked pool of athletes that we will use to select competitors regardless of the competition format. As our plans for the 2022 season develop, we will keep athletes informed. We greatly appreciate everyone's patience and understanding.

As always, we want to produce safe competitions that are fair to competitors and exciting for fans. We are confident that 2022 will be an extraordinary year for STIHL TIMBERSPORTS®. To apply for the 2022 season, the following must be completed and returned by **January 31** to Granite State Lumberjack Shows.

- 1. Athlete Application
- 2. Competitor Resume
- 3. Advisory Committee Elections
- 4. \$100 Registration Fee (via check)

## **Application**

To be considered for inclusion in the 2022 STIHL TIMBERSPORTS® men, women, or rookie competitions, you must complete and return the application, resume, Advisory Committee elections, and \$100 registration fee by <u>January 31, 2022</u>. This fee will be returned to anyone not selected for competition, or if we are forced to cancel competitions. Additionally, this fee will be returned to competing athletes following the close of the national season, as long as the athlete appears at the qualifier and championship (if applicable).

### **Competition Format and Pools**

Competition format and pools are subject to change. Pools for the regional qualifier competitions will be selected by Granite State Lumberjack Shows based on the applications and resumes submitted, with input from the Advisory Committee.

- Men: There will be 5 regional pools of 8 athletes for a total of 40 men competitors.
  The top 4 individuals from each region (20 total) will move on to the U.S.
  Championship semifinals to make 2 pools of 10. The top 5 from those pools (10 total) will then move on to the U.S. Championship finals.
- **Women:** There will be 4 regional pools of 6-8 athletes for a total of 30 women competitors. The top 3 individuals from each region (12 total) will move on to the U.S. Championship.
- **Rookies:** The rookie athlete selection process will be conducted through applications. Pools will be determined based on the number of qualified applicants. To be eligible to compete in the rookie division, the applicant must meet the following conditions:
  - o Under the age of 25 on January 1 to compete in the respective year.
  - Athletes must not have already competed in an official STIHL TIMBERSPORTS® competition with all six disciplines.
  - Note: The qualifiers do not count as official STIHL TIMBERSPORTS® competitions. If you have competed in the U.S. Championship semifinals or finals, you are not eligible to compete in the rookie division.

#### 2022 Events

Events will be hosted and administered by regional organizers, STIHL TIMBERSPORTS® and Granite State Lumberjack Shows. Below is the tentative schedule of 2022 events:

#### **Rules and Regulations**

The following exceptions will be applicable for U.S. competition in 2022:

- The Men's Regional Qualifiers and Men's Semifinals will be held in the traditional U.S. individual competition format.
- An assistant wedger (with spray) will be allowed for the single buck in both men's and women's qualifiers.



#### **Advisory Committee**

The purpose of the men's and women's Advisory Committee is to assist the STIHL TIMBERSPORTS® organizers and ensure a safe and fair competition. Through regular communication, the committees and STIHL share ideas and suggestions. Athletes should feel free to communicate any questions or concerns to their regional representative.

#### 2022 Advisory Committee Elections

For 2022 there will be both a men's and women's Advisory Committee consisting of 5 members, and rookies will be represented by both committees. The term for each Advisory Committee member will be for the annual season (approximately January–December). Advisory Committee members' general duties are as follows:

- Assist Granite State Lumberjack Shows with ranking of athletes and pool assignments for the season.
- Work with the Assistant Global Sports Director to ensure the qualification and competition process is fair for the entire field of athletes within the official rules and regulations of STIHL TIMBERSPORTS®.
- Receive input from athletes and present issues or concerns to the Assistant Global Sports Director. This pertains to specific occurrences within competitions, broad season topics, or issues with rules and regulations.
- Assist with the selection of Team USA for the STIHL TIMBERSPORTS® World Championship relay.
- Maintain continual discussion in regards to growth of the sport for the betterment of the athlete community.
